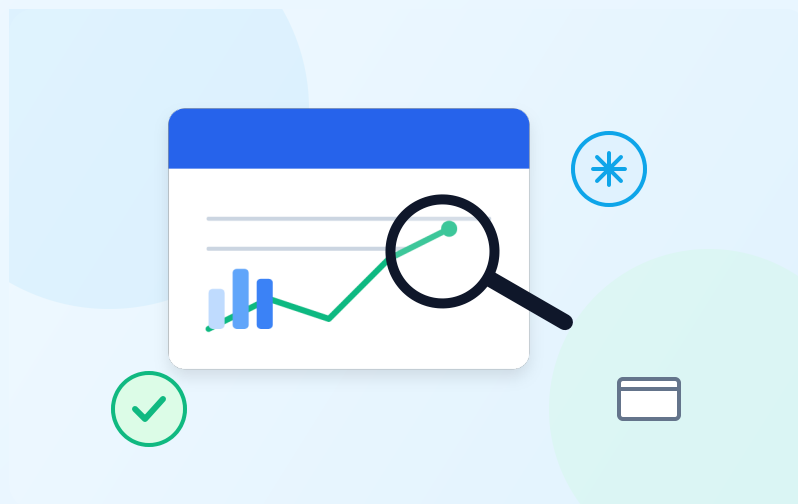

# Introduction: Why Most Websites Fail to Rank

# Step 1: Technical SEO Audit

---

Technical SEO is the foundation. If your house is built on sand, it doesn't matter how nice the curtains are. Google needs to be able to access, crawl, and index your site without issues.

## Technical Checklist

- Crawl Errors:** Check for pages returning 404 (Not Found) errors.
- Indexing Issues:** Ensure important pages are not blocked by robots.txt.
- Page Speed:** Core Web Vitals must be "Good" (LCP under 2.5s).
- Mobile Usability:** No horizontal scrolling; text readable without zooming.
- HTTPS Status:** Site must have a valid SSL certificate (Lock icon).

**Pro Tip:** Use Google Search Console immediately. It's free data directly from Google telling you exactly what problems they see on your site.

## Step 2: On-Page SEO Audit

---

Once the technical foundation is solid, we look at individual pages. On-Page SEO ensures Google understands exactly what each page is about.



### On-Page Checklist

- Title Tags:** Under 60 chars, includes primary keyword at start.
  - Meta Descriptions:** Compelling copy, under 160 chars, encourages clicks.
  - Keyword Placement:** Primary keyword in first 100 words.
  - H1–H3 Structure:** One H1 per page, logical H2/H3 subheaders.
  - Internal Linking:** Link to other relevant posts on your site.

## Step 3: Content Audit

---

Content is King, but only if it's the right content. This step identifies which pages are performing and which are dead weight.



### Content Checklist

- Thin Content:** Find pages with very few words and expand them.
- Duplicate Content:** Ensure canonical tags are used for similar pages.
- Keyword Gaps:** Topics competitors rank for that you don't.
- Freshness:** Update old articles with 2026 data/info.
- Readability:** Aim for Grade 8-9 reading level (Flesch-Kincaid).

**Action Item:** Look at your “Bounce Rate”. If it’s 80%+, users aren’t finding what they expect. Rewrite the intro to match their intent.

## Step 4: Backlink Audit

---

Backlinks are votes of confidence from other websites. However, in 2026, quality beats quantity. One link from a major news site is worth 1,000 links from spammy directories.

### Backlink Checklist

- Toxic Backlinks:** Identify links from gambling/porn sites and disavow them.
- Domain Authority (DA):** Track your DA growth over time.
- Competitor Analysis:** See who links to your competitors and replicate.

**Warning:** Never buy bulk backlinks. Google penalties are manual and extremely difficult to recover from.

### Tools for Links

Use **Ahrefs** or **Semrush** for the most accurate backlink databases.

## Step 5: UX & Conversion Audit

---

SEO isn't just about traffic; it's about conversion. If users click but leave immediately, your SEO suffers. Google measures user satisfaction.

### UX Checklist

- Bounce Rate:** Analyze pages with high exit rates.
- Mobile UX:** Buttons are thumb-friendly (min 44×44 pixels).
- CTA Placement:** Is the Call to Action above the fold?

**Clarity:** Does the page structure guide the eye logically?

## Common SEO Mistakes to Avoid

1. **Ignoring Mobile Speed:** Most traffic is mobile. If your site is slow on 4G/5G, you lose.
2. **Keyword Stuffing:** Don't force keywords. Write for humans first.
3. **Broken Links:** Nothing kills trust faster than a 404 error.
4. **No Internal Linking:** Orphan pages (pages with no links pointing to them) won't rank.
5. **Thin Content:** Publishing 300-word posts does not work anymore.
